ORDINANCE NO. 023

NAMING A ROAD IN BARANGAY ZONE VI, FROM THE CORNER OF GARCIA ST; TO NESTOR TRINIDAD, AS EVARISTO D. ESCUSA ST.

Introduced by Kgd. Lilia Butaran

WHEREAS, the late Evaristo D. Escusa, who died in Sept. 06, 1995 was a distinguished citizen of Iba, Zambales, as a former Municipal Mayor (1947-1951). World War II Veteran (USAFFE Bataan 1941-1946) and member of the Armed Force of the Philippines (AFP) from 1951-1967, with a rank of Lieutenant Colonel; when he retired;

WHEREAS, the Veterans Service Office of the Department of National Defense of Washington USA, honored him and presented five (5) medals, to his Son, Dante such as liberation Medal, Philippine Defense Medal, Philippine Independence Medal, and Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal, for his service in the Philippine Army during World War III, which include surviving the Bataan Death March;

WHEREAS, his passion also included writing about the Legend and History of Iba, Zambales, where he chronicled the great men and women produced in this town, originally known as Paynauen, established by the Spaniard in 1611;

WHEREAS; Capt. Evaristo D. Escusa, was awarded the military Commendation ribbon for his role in anti-banditry operation in Sulu, resulting in the surrender of 21 outlaws, including Asa, a top henchman of Kamlon. He was elected Mayor of Iba but was called to active service in 1951 and assigned to Public Affairs Office of the DND.

WHEREAS, this contribution and Legacy of the late Evaristo P. Escusa should be recognized as a gesture of reciprocity of the people for the sacrifices and services he had given for the people Iba, Zambales.

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, Zambales.

SECTION 1 – To honor and perpetuate the memory and contribution of the late Evaristo Escusa, The road from the Corner of Garcia St. to Nestor Trinidad St. in Barangay Zone VI, Iba, Zambales is hereby named after him.

SECTION 2 – The street name shall be installed by the Municipal Engineering Office on both ends of the road and both corner of the National Highway traversed by this road.

SECTION 3 – This ordinance takes effect upon approval.
